

NOTICE OF EXPIRING POSITIONS

The Kittitas County Conservation District (KCCD) has two expiring positions on the Board of Supervisors. The Board is made up of five members, three of which are elected locally and the other two are appointed by the Washington State Conservation Commission. One elected position and one appointed position expire in 2019.

- **Individuals interested in the elected position** must submit a Candidate Information Form to the KCCD office (2211 W Dolarway Road, Ste 4, Ellensburg) by **4:30PM on Tuesday, January 15, 2019**. Candidates wishing to have their name pre-printed on the election ballots must also submit a nominating petition complete with 25 valid signatures of registered voters residing in the KCCD boundaries. Any candidates not submitting a nominating petition will be a “declared write-in” and their name will not be pre-printed on the ballots. Nominating Petitions must also be submitted by **4:30 PM on Tuesday, January 15, 2019**. Both the candidate information form and the nominating petition form are available on the KCCD website (www.kccd.net) or by contacting the KCCD at 925-3352 or 2211 W. Dolarway Rd, Suite 4, Ellensburg. **The election is scheduled for February 12, 2019.**
- **Individuals interested in the appointed position** must complete the **AF1 –Conservation District Appointed Supervisor Application** found on the Washington State Conservation Commission’s webpage (<http://scc.wa.gov/elections/>). The application must be filled out in its entirety and submitted by **March 31, 2019** in order for the applicant to be considered for appointment.

The KCCD is a political sub-division of the state with over a 75-year history of serving the landowners, land managers and the general public in Kittitas County. The Board of Supervisors completes long range and annual plans that direct natural resource priorities and activities. The Board meets at least monthly, to implement both plans and direct a staff of eight. For more information about the KCCD, please visit our website (www.kccd.net).
