A. NRCS Programs

- 1. **District Conservationist Report** Alex Reyes, Acting DC provided a written report reviewed by the Board. Reuben Garnett provided additional information.
- B. Financial Manager Position After last week's Special Meeting, an offer was made to Emily Love. The background check and credit check were completed successfully. She accepted the offer and starts on October 21, 2024.
- C. 2024 Kittitas County Hazard Mitigation Plan -The Kittitas County Hazard Mitigation Plan is currently out for comment through November 7, 2024. KCCD has an annex in this document. Once the plan is finalized an approved by FEMA, KCCD will need to formally adopt it. That's not likely to happen until December or January.
- D. South Central Area Meeting Goldendale 10/30/2024 Central Klickitat Conservation District is hosting the 2024 South Central Area Meeting to be held at the Goldendale Observatory State Park in Goldendale on Wednesday, October 30th.

VI. Action Items

A. CWDG

1. Cost Share Contracts- Anna reported that additional CWDG landowner projects have been developed on north Cle Elum Ridge. These projects will help lengthen the fuel breaks which have already been constructed and are adjacent to the Airport Project for the City of Cle Elum. They will also help protect a major power line running along the top of Cle Elum Ridge. They are 120 acres with Hein & Hein Enterprise LLC for \$144,000 and 130 acres with Harry James Masterson Testamentary Trust for \$192,000. Both projects include a landowner contribution.

B. YTAHP

1. Cascade at Coleman Creek Project Anna reported that the Cascade at Coleman Creek Project is currently out for bid. The pre-bid meeting earlier this week was attended by nearly 20 potential bidders. The bid due date was set for October 15 but will be extended to at least October 22. That is not ideal as any days added take away from lead times for materials, but the engineers did not include reinforcement specs so they will be issued in an addendum. The contractors need at least a week to review and put together their bids. Once the bids are received, if they are within the budget, contracting needs to move quickly. Anna requested approval of the Board to move forward with the low responsive and responsible bidder if the bid is within the available project funding.

MOTION - Approve the low responsive and responsible bid for the Cascade at Coleman Creek Fish Passage and Screening Project and authorize the District Manager to execute a contract contingent on being within the project budget and review by the Board Chair.
